

Measures against COVID-19 infections

at Kanazawa Municipal Iozen Ski Resort

【About admission to the ski resort】

Please refrain from visiting if you have a fever of 37.5 degree or Higher, or if you are in poor physical condition such as a cold.

【While riding the lift and waiting for the lift】

- If you are riding a lift or other customers or ski resort staffs are nearby, please wear a mask (neck warmer, etc.) and gloves,
- Even outdoors, please refrain from talking loudly in places where people can easily gather, such as waiting for a lift or while riding. Also, when riding the chairlift, please ride while facing forward as much as possible.
- The number of passengers on the lift will be decided based on the waiting time during congestion.

【Ticket sales】

- Ticket counters are separated by a Splash prevention sheet.
- When handing over money, use a saucer to prevent skin contact.
- You can pay with the Pay Pay payment system.
- When used by multiple people, the representative should purchase in bulk as much as possible.

【About the use of rest areas (Visitor house)】

〈Inside the building〉

- Please keep a mask (neck warmer, face mask) on in the building (visitor house).
- There is no footwear such as slippers, so please bring your own.
- We will limit the number of people in the break spaces below.
(Break room:30 seats, Lounge space:36 seats **Total 66 seats**)
- Those who use the rest area (not including the use of the toilet) are required to measure the temperature and fill out the "personal reception form".
※If you have a fever of 37.5 ° C or higher or a cold symptom, you will not be allowed to enter the room.
- On Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, it cannot be used exclusively by groups.
- There are no lockers, so please manage your luggage yourself.
- We do not have a trash can, so please be sure to take it home with you.

〈Break room〉

- Please refrain from staying for a long time.
- Please cooperate with alcohol disinfection of hands and fingers, washing hands regularly.
- Do not move the installed table or chair. (To keep a social distance)
- Do not leave your luggage on the table or chair for a long time to save space.
- Please cooperate as we will ventilate the room regularly.

〈Weekday group use〉

- The maximum number of people in the break room is 30 and please refrain from staying for a long time.
- Please grasp the health status confirmation (temperature measurement) of all users in advance, fill in the necessary items on the "confirmation slip" before entering the room, and submit it.
- Please shift the meal time by rotation so as not to exceed the number of people in the room

【Toilet】

- For those who only use the toilet, the staff will not measure the temperature of the user.
- Please cooperate with alcohol disinfection of hands and fingers at the entrance.
- Toilets and handrails are regularly cleaned and disinfected.

【Ski resort staff】

- Every morning, we carry out temperature measurement and health check before going to work.
- Thoroughly carry out personal health management (hand washing and alcohol disinfection of hands and fingers).
- Wear a mask (neck warmer, etc) and gloves.
- Ventilate the room diligently. (Office, driver's cab, monitoring room)
- Shared items such as tables and chairs are regularly disinfected.
- Thoroughly wash hands and disinfect hands and fingers before and during work.

- Check the health condition of the staff at the start of work.
- Keep a social distance to reduce the risk of infection.
- Avoid the front as much as possible when talking.
- Refrain from talking during meals.
- The driver's cab and monitoring room can only be entered by one person, and when multiple people enter, the windows will be opened to avoid three Cs (Closed spaces, Crowded places, Close-contact settings).
- Morning assembly, closing ceremony, and roll call will be held while avoiding three Cs and keeping a social distance.
- If the staff is not feeling well, contact the person in charge immediately and follow the instructions.
- If the staff member's family members are infected or suspected of being infected, they will not go to work, contact the nearest medical institution, and follow the instructions.
- Make staff aware of the importance of infection prevention measures, and strive for self-management and thorough infection prevention.

【Patrol staff】

- Carry out temperature measurement and health check before going to work.
- Always carry a mask, etc., and wear it flexibly when performing rescue activities.
- Equipment used in rescue activities (rescue board, etc.) will be disinfected after use.

【School】

- Please cooperate with the temperature measurement at the reception before the school lesson. Then, if you have a fever of 37.5 degree or higher, you can not attend the school lesson.
- Instructors will carry out temperature measurement and health check before going to work.
- Instructors and staff will wear masks (neck warmers, face mask) and gloves.
- We will implement splash prevention measures near the reception.
- We will secure a space (1m or more) that can keep a certain distance at the reception.
- During the lesson, instructors will give you the necessary instructions to maintain a social distance.
- Special attention should be paid to close contacts in lessons for beginners, beginners and children.

【What to do if an employee is infected】

- Follow the instructions of the health center / medical institution.
- We will promptly report the infection to each local transport bureau.
- Based on the range of activities of infected people, we will consider measures such as disinfecting the work place and making workers at the same work place wait at home.
- We will consider the human rights of infected persons and be careful not to identify their personal names.
- We will establish a communication system between the health

manager or health and safety promoter and the health center, and cooperate with the hearing of the health center.

【Other infection control】

- Other infection control measures will be implemented based on the Guidelines provided by Kanazawa Sports Facilities & Activities Foundation.
