Suitable for beginners, average slope of about 10 degrees, snowboarding possible

· Beginner practice zone

On Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, a beginner practice zone is set up on a gently sloping slope, so even beginners can practice safely. Plastic skis and plastic snowboards are available.

· Sled slope

You can play sledging. Plastic skis and plastic snowboards are available.

· Mt. Kigo Visitor House (breaks, toilets, vending machines)

Uncompressed snow, suitable for advanced users, average slope of about 21 degrees (maximum slope of 37 degrees), extension 500 m.

Suitable for intermediate / advanced users, average slope 17 degrees (maximum slope 32 degrees), extension 520 m

Forest road course (beginner)

Suitable for beginners, average slope of about 10 degrees, extension 2,000 m

· Sled slope

You can play sledging. Plastic skis and plastic snowboards are available.

The pair lift ticket office sells only on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Rental skis are located in the Tomoshibi dining room opposite the family slope (only on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, closed during the yearend and New Year holidays).

About rental sleds

- · Please use after confirming the safety of the surroundings and the safety of the sliding course.
- · Do not use in any place other than the designated place.
- · When used by infants and elementary school students, be sure to use it under the supervision of a guardian.
- · One use is up to 2 hours. If you want to extend it, please go to the reception again.
- Please be sure to observe the return time.
- · If the sled is damaged or lost, please be sure to inform the reception.

Handling of lift tickets

- · One-time tickets and coupon tickets are valid only during the season of purchase.
- Morning tickets, afternoon tickets, and one-day tickets are valid only on the day of the event.
- Purchased lift tickets cannot be refunded.
- · Please note that even if the ticket is lost, it cannot be reissued, and even if the lift is temporarily suspended due to stormy weather or strong winds, or the business hours are shortened, refunds and usage hours cannot be extended.
- · When boarding the lift, be sure to show the lift ticket to the staff. If you do not show it, you will not be able to board.

In order for our customers to use the facility safely, please observe the following items.

- •Page about measures to prevent second-hand smoke
 The property is non-smoking on site, including ski areas, visitor houses
 and parking. There is no place to smoke
- From July 1, 2019, there is no place to smoke.
 (For all premises including inside and outside the building and parking lot)
- You cannot smoke heated cigarettes or electronic cigarettes.
- Please refrain from smoking on the streets, even outside the premises, as it may cause inconvenience to local residents and passers-by.
- · If the staff sees smoking during the patrol, we will speak to you.
- Employees working at facilities managed by this corporation have been quitting smoking during working hours since April 1.
- •Please cooperate with the new coronavirus infection control (COVID-19).

- •Please purchase the lift ticket at the ticket office. (One-time tickets and coupon tickets are valid only during the season, and one-day and half-day tickets are valid only on the day.)
- * Lift tickets are sold only on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays (excluding the year-end and New Year holidays). On weekdays, please purchase at the Family Lift Ticket Office.
- Purchased lift tickets are non-refundable.
- •Due to lack of snow or bad weather, we may temporarily close or shorten business hours. (If the business hours areunseasonable weather, the lift ticket will not be refunded.)
- ·Skiing on areas other than the slopes maintained by this ski resort is prohibited.
- •Please refrain from climbing, crossing or walking on the slopes as it will interfere with the skiers.

- In addition, we do not allow the use of skis other than skis and snowboards, and the use of plastic skis, plastic snowboards, and sleds on the ski slopes as it is dangerous.
- •On the Sledding Slope, you can only use plastic sleds, plastic skis, and plastic snowboards.
- ·It is dangerous to run backwards on the forest road course or climb on foot, so we refuse.
- •Do not enter non-skid areas separated by no-entry tape or safety nets.
- •The lift can only be used by those who ski or snowboard. Also, you cannot board from the down line
- •Rental skis and snowboards can be rented at the cafeteria opposite the family slope or at the Iozen Sports Center. (Iozen Sports Center rents only skis and sleds)
- ·If you are worried about getting on the lift, please inform the staff in advance. We will assist you when getting on and off.
- The only restaurant around the ski resort is "Tomoshibi Shokudo" opposite the family slopes.
- Open only on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays (closed from December 29th to 1 / 3rd)
- · When the weather is rough, we may not be open.
- •Be sure to use the designated parking lot and do not park on the street.
- ·Animals such as dogs and cats and pets are not allowed.
